

# STORE COUPON ISSUE RE-ALIGNMENT: LAST 6 SERIES

As mentioned in the President's Message, the series are being changed to reflect the true definitions of a series the way they were first set out. Those definitions were as follows:

1. A change in the basic design of the coupon.
2. A change in the numbering format ie: color, size or number of digits.
3. A change of signatures.

What we were calling the CTC S24 contains 3 denominations: 25¢, 50¢ & \$1.00, all issued by the Canadian Bank Note Co. The \$1.00 was issued first and although both front and back plates are identical to the CTC S-23 dated 1998, the '99' prefix in the serial number was the reason for the new series S24 when actually it should be part of the S23 series but with a "99" prefix similar to the EZ & EY of the S9 series.

The 50¢ & 25¢ notes were created using 1992 plates and were identical to the CTC S17 coupons with the exception of the '99' prefix in the serial number therefore they are now part of the S17 series.

The old S25 series containing only the 10¢ and dollar with a "2" prefix are now in the CTC S20 series were they should be.

This results in all subsequent series being reassigned new numbers. I would strongly suggest you keep the following chart handy to identify coupons you may be confused about. We have also included photos of the various coupons identified to aid you. As more denominations come out, we will try to be more constant in our numbering and try to better respect the original series definitions.


