Special thanks to Jerome Fourre, Don Bradt, Lou Fontaine and Doug Adams for all the varieties you have found and shared with us. But really fellows, you need to get out more. I ask only one small favor. In the future could you please tell me every variety in a series to look for, having already gone through the particular series ten times for previous varieties you mentioned.

Finally to Dean Neald #602 for your article on pages 8 & 9 of the same issue. There are some additional differences. On the front, the 'W' in Wayne has a beginning stroke at the bottom on S26-B but not on S27-B1. The 'a' is attached to the 'p' in Pasternak on S27-B but not on S27-B1. On the reverse side, the English at the bottom is in larger print on S26-B as indicated by the location of the final word 'business'. You mentioned the 5 rows and 12 columns of leaves on the reverse of S26-B. I love patterns. Rows 1, 3, 5 are identical with every other leaf identical, while rows 2 and 4 are identical but different from rows 1, 3, 5 in having every other leaf identical, that is, there are 4 different angled leaves. Finally the serial numbers are different. I just had to add that.

Everybody keep up the great work. I appreciate your articles.
