Toby Grimminck #338 showed me a moving “K” on CTC S20-C. The K at the end of Stanley Pasternak’s signature has 4 basic positions. In the figures 1 through 4, the top of the K has moved from the normal position outside the white

triangle, to the edge of the triangle, to just inside the edge to a final position about 1mm inside the triangle. The signature hasn’t actually moved but rather the grey background with the white triangle has moved.

I do have, however, a coupon with a voyage that sails north from Cape Breton instead of south like all the other examples. I thought my voyage must have been made a little earlier than the others, but my new northern voyage is serial # T1388909, which makes it later than my T0421324 southern voyage. If someone has a better stash of the voyage in/out coupons, I’d be curious where my serial number sits relative to all the others. Did the line start north of Cape Breton, or was this it’s final location.

Also, if someone else has a northern voyage or two, we could make this a legitimate variety, instead of an just an entry in my weirdo file.
