## **DOUBLE YOUR MONEY 1¢ COUPONS**

Back in the April 2005 issue of the COLLECTOR (VOL.15, No.2, page 34) Jerome wrote an article on this very same topic. At the same time, Jerome listed the known coupons in 3 series, the featured product of the week, the listed ongoing specials, the colour of the back text, and assigned a series range number. Bill Symes and Toby Grimminck aided his research.

Well, in the last 3 years since this published listing there of course have been changes, and more weekly specials have been discovered in all 3 series, by several collectors, thus expanding the listing.

When Jerome set up the 3 series he based the series criteria on the front of the coupon. For instance Series 100 was an unserial numbered 1¢ coupon with the full black border and a green printed maple leaf background with 'CTC' in the centre of each maple leaf and printed on white bond paper. Series 200 was exactly same as Series 100, but with an added double red serial number. Series 300 was altogether different showing a miniature 1¢ coupon together with a printed redemption chart to list all gas bar coupons, printed in black ink on green cheque paper.

While going through my DYM coupons and sorting for doubles and checking off what I had to Jerome's list-

ing I indeed found 7 coupons not on Jerome's list. These 7 notes were featured in the 'discoveries' section our last COLLECTOR.

However, perhaps even more interesting was that I noticed another difference on the FRONT of the 100 series coupons, and so far, only on the 100 series coupons. The fact that on some 100 series coupons the four  $1 \not\in$  denomination squares in the corners are blank or white. All other coupons in the 100 & 200 series are 'filled' in with the green maple leaf background described earlier.

Since the discovery, I have shown this 'variety' to both Jerome and Bill plus I made it a topic of discussion and showed the members the difference at the June CTCCC/TOREX meeting.

I suppose we were all so interested in checking the back for the latest weekly special; this rather 'obvious' anomaly had escaped detection for over 45 years!

Now after discussions with Jerome, Bill and other collectors, we have decided to renumber this entire DYM group to reflect this 4th series. Also in the new series coupon numbering you will be able to tell how many listed ongoing specials there are on the back, by the coupon identification number.

So the following will be the 4 new series:

DYM 1000: 2 red serial numbers, black border, green background filling in the four

1¢ corner denominations, printed on regular bond paper.

DYM 2000: No serial numbers, black border, green background filling in the four 1¢

corner denominations, printed on regular bond paper.

DYM 3000: No serial numbers, black border, green background, but four 1¢ corner

denominations are blank (white), printed on regular bond paper.

DYM 4000: Green redemption voucher with miniature 1¢ coupon, printed on green

cheque paper.

This selected order we feel represents the correct chronological order of issuance, with the serial numbered notes first, then no serial numbers, then the blank denominations and finally the cheque paper redemption list.

Now the second number in this new identification (or the '100' number) represents the number of listed ongoing specials printed on the back in addition of course to whatever the weekly special was for that coupon.

The third and fourth number is the weekly special ID number. Since no series has over 100 different weekly specials, 2 digits will do to simplify cataloguing.

It is interesting to note that with new numbering system, the coupons do not all run sequentially but unlike the old system where gaps were left when listed ongoing specials changed, now they are grouped in 100's. This should give us more room for future discoveries and simplify sorting.

It was also noted by Jerome, Bill and myself that the newly discovered blank corner denominations are not as common when compared to the current listed 100 series from where they were originally discovered. We speculate that this variety likely came from a later printing. Either that, or maybe only 1 or 2 coupons on the plate were blanked out creating a smaller quantity. (One or 2 notes per sheet)

Since this "Double Your Money" program ran for a number of years and the coupons were undated, the same special could be repeated when time of year and supplies warranted it. That assumption could explain the fact that I have both a filled-in 4 corner denomination and a blank one, white 4 corner denomination with exactly the same back, however the 2 coupons could have been issued 1 or 2 years apart. They could have also came off the same sheet, if both varieties were printed together.

One other note. The framing and background of the series 1000, 2000 and 3000 are exactly the same as the in-house printed 1¢, 2¢, 3¢ & 4¢ coupons. The only exception is the background colour – green on the DYM coupons and orange on the 1¢ to 4¢ notes. I have not found any 1¢ to 4¢ coupons with blank denominations in the corners.

This leaves us to believe that these blank denomination notes are indeed specific to the DYM coupons only.

This whole series issued by CTC and printed in-house in the early 1960's is of course the early forerunner of the current weekly product coupons. Same parallels too, as we often see the same products available from year to year. The big difference is that they are now all dated and the printing is contracted out.


