CTC S19-Ga STUDY UPDATE

Following the article printed in the October 2007 newsletter and your great response there is now a total of 48 known CTC S19-Ga coupons.

By examining the known notes it is clear that 1 sheet of 50 notes was put into circulation. This sheet was sheet #001. The serial numbers range from 1750000001 increasing by 1000 to 1750049001.

There were also 500 notes in the 1750013500 to 1750013999 range that were issued and 500 more from 1750049500 to 1750049999.

This means that a total of 1,050 notes were issued for collectors to find. Not all the notes would have survived, but there is a good chance of still finding one in circulation if you have access to quantities of coupons.
