### IS IT REALLY UNIQUE?

This 3¢ orange coupon bears the prefix "W" and is signed by F.SASAKI and D.MUNCASTER.

### SIMILARITIES

As in series CTC2, CTC3 and CTC4, the words "ECONOMIE SECURITE" and "SAVE SAFETY" are printed on the side borders. On the reverse, the words "CUSTOMER PROFIT - SHARING BONUS" are also printed on the lower border. The printing and denomination are also identical.

### DIFFERENCES

In comparison with the above mentioned series, the signatures are different. On this CTC9 coupon, A.Billes' signature is replaced by the new president D.Muncaster. The prefix and serial number are also different. The "W" prefix is bigger and thicker and the serial number is bigger and thinner than the ones in the other series. On the reverse of said coupon, the inscription "MOR POWER GAS" does not appear on the sign.
