Canadian Tire Corporation coupon collectors appear headed for an exceptional year following the issuance by CTC of two radically dissimilar coupons!

In a corporate concession to inflation, the Canadian Tire Corporation has hit the streets with a \$2 cash bonus coupon! The corporation has actually been sitting on these coupons for a while, as they bear a close resemblance to the series CTC-SII of 1989, with their large black serial numbers.
