

The YELLOW two's are out

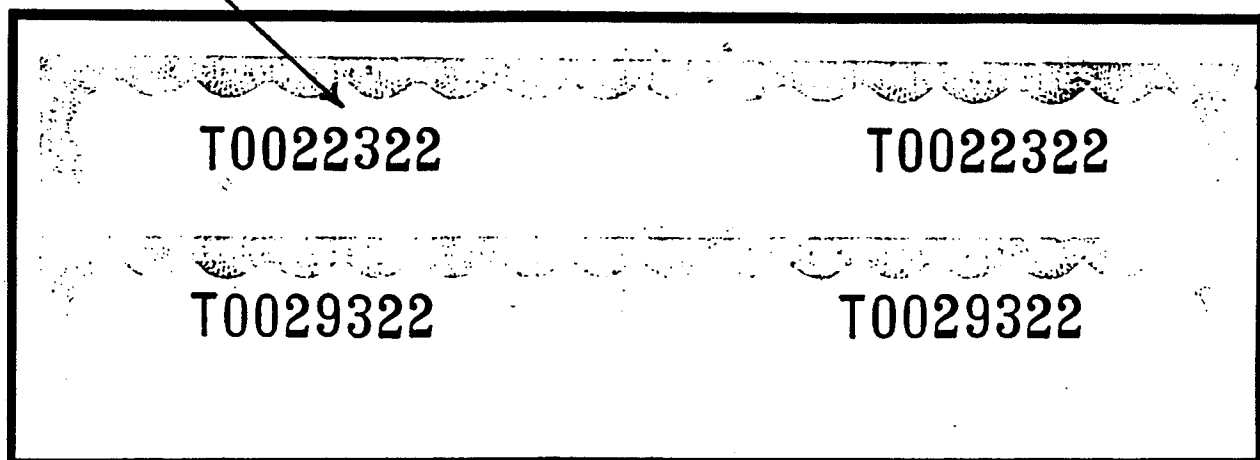

The Corporation has finally released the **YELLOW** two dollar coupons (CTC S11-F) for circulation. Don Robb was the first to report them in his area (Waterloo) and I have gone through about \$10,000.00 worth at one of my dealers. He ordered them to replenish his coupon stock in time for the *Victoria day promotion* that was held province-wide, if not nation-wide.

Some of the coupons that they received were up in the Two Hundred thousand range, although Don Robb reports they are up to Two Hundred Fifty thousand in his area. I found a total of two replacement coupons in the lot.

Earlier I managed to get some of these two's with a small three as the fifth digit on the left serial number (see top note in illustration). They seem to be only on a small amount of coupons judging from the other coupon (see bottom note in illustration) which would suggest only one numbering head on a sheet of forty coupons of this kind was used. It is theoretically possible that other numbers (1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, or 0) in the same size and style, in the preceding and following coupons, exist.

I would be interested to be in contact with anyone who has any of the other serial numbers for trading purposes. If anyone is interested in purchasing a set of two coupons as in the illustration, I would be interested to sell a set for \$6.43 in Canadian Tire money only. C.T.C.C.C. AUCTION RULES

At a recent executive/directors meeting of the C.T.C.C.C., it was decided to review the existing auction rules due to the growing size of our auctions, and it was decided to amend some of our current auction structure as follows:

1. Any member can enter material into the C.T.C.C.C. auction provided that:
 - a) all lots are C.T.C.C.C. related items. i.e.: coupons, catalogues, calenders, other paper advertising promos of related interest, and perhaps, some other C.T.C. memorabilia of general interest to the membership.
NOTE: The discretion of **ALL MATERIAL** being entered into the C.T.C.C.C. auction remains with the Auction Chairman)
 - b) A maximum of 8 lots per member, per auction only.
 - c) **ALL AUCTION MATERIAL** to be sent in **ADVANCE** to the Auction Chairman by mail, courier etc, and to be received no later than one week before the next scheduled auction.
2. The auction not to exceed 60 lots at any one meeting.
3. The introduction of printing upcoming auction material in our newsletters **PRIOR** to an auction meeting date, and the possibility of the introduction of **MAIL-IN** bids has yet to be finalized.
