Sandy McTire Update

Over the past few months we have been able to make some adjustments in our Sandy McTire coupon numbering system. The changes are as follows:

- To be consistent with Paper Money collector terminology we will now use "Face" and "Back" instead of "Obverse" and "Reverse".
- 2) Add newly discovered coupon:

MP2B-20J

Gray

Red Red Clear

3) Change MP2B-40D to have a "Red" Back design. The use of "Rose" was an error.

4) In the MP2C series we have a situation where the MP2C-10C' coupon has both a 5 digit and a 6 digit serial number. In the Sandy McTire series this is the only coupon which has a 5 digit serial number. After discussion with other collectors it was agreed that the 5 digit coupon should be recognized with a separate number. This will be done as follows:

MP2C-10C1*

MP2C-10C2

(Foot Note) * 5 Digit Serial Number

- 5) In the PS1B series please delete "PS1B-30E". I have now confirmed that this coupon does not exist.
- In the PS2B series please add a "1" to make the numbering in this series consistent with other series: PS2B-PS2B-10-2 10-1
- With the recent addition of the "PIT STOP" PS3B Series we now have 9 different coupon groups and a total of 84 different coupons in the Sandy McTire series.

"SANDY McTIRE" COUPONS

There are three major types of Sandy McTire coupons: Mor-Power Gas Bars; Canadian Tire Gas Bars; and Pit stop(s). Combine these three types with three different coupon back designs and the two types of paper used (Bond "B" and Cheque "C") and the result is nine different coupon groups. The numbering system is organized to differentiate the nine groups as follows:

MOR-POWER GAS BARS:

MP1B & MP1C "Do You Know?"

MP2B & MP2C "We Pay Half!"

MP3B

"Free Membership"

CANADIAN TIRE GAS BARS:

GB1B "Free Membership"

PIT STOPS:

With Serial Numbers P\$1B

"Free Membership"

PS2B

No Serial Numbers

"Free Membership"

PIT STOP:

PS3B No Serial Numbers "Free Membership"

MP1B: MOR-POWER GAS BARS - "DO YOU KNOW?"

- All coupons are printed on regular Bond paper

Plaid Border around a "Yellow Panel" - FACE:

All coupons have two Red Serial Numbers

"Good Only At Our Toronto And Suburban Lubritoriums"

All have a "Gray" Denomination Number

All have "DO YOU KNOW?" statement - BACK:

Most have a "Small Seal" Underprint and others are "Clear"
