

C.T.C.C.C. LOW/HIGH SERIAL NUMBER STUDY

Fellow club member Gary Doran and I are about to compile a consolidated club low/high serial number listing which will attempt to provide a more accurate account of all mintage figures of all coupons printed by the two bank note companies as well as in-house coupons printed by C.T.C. itself.

This listing, when completed, will be printed in a future issue of the newsletter as an information guide, and will be updated and re-printed as deemed practical, as more information is found and compiled. However, in order to undertake this project, we need **YOUR** input!

If you currently keep a LOW/HIGH list of your Canadian Tire coupon serial numbers, we would be interested in hearing from you. Your list does not need to be 100% complete either, but it must be legible. It can be hand-written, typed, or computer generated and can range from a few coupons, to a complete set. You can use either the current Bilodeau or the Charlton numbering systems. We are looking for low/high information for **ALL NUMBERED COUPONS**, gas bar, store, lubritoriums, Hercules Coupons, the XV series, and lube chit notes. If you do not have a listing, this would be a great time to start yours and at the same time help us out.

The only stipulation is that *you must have the coupons you list the numbers for in your collection* to make this Master List authentic. If you are interested in being a part of this study, please forward your most recent list together with the following information:

Your Name, Membership number, Address,
Telephone number: day, evening and include area code
Date of your listing (should be reasonably current)
Catalogue numbering system used and any relative comments.

Note: We will accept information from anyone including non-members providing the information and source is accurate and genuine. Therefore, if you know of someone who is a collector, but not a member, we will accept their list too. (And maybe even get them to join the club!) Please send your listings to either:
