A few weeks ago I was able to get a number of 75th Anniversary coupons still in the "fresh from the banknote company" cellophane wrappers with the red opening strip. I was also lucky enough to get a bundle of low serial numbers for the \$1.00 coupons. The bundle in question was serial numbers 7500000601 to 7500000800, except that coupon 7500000601 wasn't there and was replaced. The replacement coupon was a VERY used S15 (Pasternak-Macaulay) with serial number 0004015066. This coupon wasn't even printed by the same banknote company!! Maybe we have a collector at British American Banknote Company? There was also a piece of blue paper cut to coupon size between coupons ..700 and ..701.

I noticed this "variety" a couple of years ago when I was looking through some spare low/high serial numbers.

There are some of the CTC S11-B - F coupons that have a minor (very minor actually) print error. Sandy McTire's teeth got an extra helping of ink and are mostly black. This print error occurs near the end of this series so high/low collectors may have one in their spares. Shown below are a portion of an affected coupon and a normal coupon. Also the table below shows how interlaced this "variety" is with normal coupons.
