

CTC-S20 SERIES --- \$1.00 COUPON

As a result of the 75th Anniversary \$1.00 coupons being exhausted, CTC has begun issuing, in certain areas, the CTC S-20 series of \$1.00 notes.

Printed by the British American Bank Note Company and dated 1996 on the reverse, this new series has a very striking resemblance to the just concluded 75th Anniversary series. Actually, word has it that this new series was actually printed **BEFORE** the 75th Anniversary series and was to follow the not completed CTC S-16 & S-17 Canadian Bank Note series.



Printed in the same Steel Blue as the CTC S-18 \$1.00 notes and with all the same anti-counterfeiting devices, these coupons fit into currently issued notes very well. That is to say the overall design remains basically the same as the notes issued since 1992 except for the white counter background in the bottom right hand corner as in the CTC S-18 & S-19, 75th Anniversary series. Signatures of Stanley Pasternak and Stephen E. Bachand are also identical to the CTC S-18 & S-19 series. Even the security paper is the same as the previous two series.

Changes include the replacement of the 75th Anniversary logo with the familiar CTC Triangle logo, and reversing the positioning and re-sizing of the Corporation name in the panel immediately to the right of the triangle in the center of the note. Where english was in the upper panel on the 75th Anniversary series, english is now in the lower panel and the french text is in the upper panel above "Cash Bonus".
