

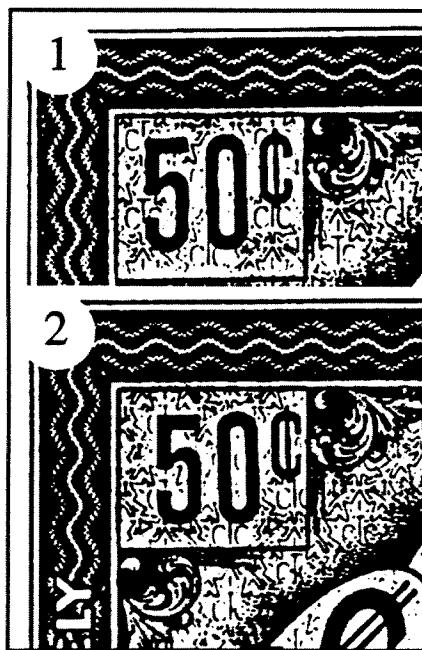

These 50¢ coupons were sent to me by Bill Cuff. Notice the difference with the c signs. Figure 1 has a regular c sign, whereas figure 2 has a pointed "C".

Bill has determined two distinct ranges for these pointed C's. They are both in the CTC 8 series as follows:

U 4532790 regular low
U 4541253 low pointed C
U 4547257 high pointed C
U 4549097 regular high

U 4634800 regular low
U 4640578 low pointed C
U 4648021 high pointed C
U 4664308 regular high

Check yours out and drop Bill a line, his address is in the last newsletter.

Bill also sent in a photocopy of a CTC S17-C - 25¢ coupon with no serial number and a CTC S18-C - 25¢ not that was folded before being printed, which when unfolded leaves a diagonal white streak (about one-eighth of an inch wide) where the printing should have been.

This 25¢ coupon was sent in by John Emmett. The background and denomination are missing. Some of the similar one's I have seen also have the denomination penciled in by some good samaritan. Others were pinned, unpinned and re-pinned to a pegboard so many times, they could be used as a strainer. They seem to come from a few sheets ie: the serial numbers finish with the 3 same digits. What is the serial number of your's? Let me know!

John also sent in a photocopy of a CTC 8-A - 5¢ coupon which he says was printed on thicker than usual paper. This is not uncommon in the Gas Bar coupons.
