A BRIEF HISTORY OF CANADIAN TIRE FINANCIAL SERVICES (CTFS)

CTFS began in 1961 as Midland Shoppers Credit Limited, a small company offering third-party credit processing for local retailers.

In 1968, Midland was servicing Canadian Tire stores and eventually was purchased by Canadian Tire and became a wholly owned subsidiary of Canadian Tire Corporation, Limited. At this time it was renamed Canadian Tire Acceptance Limited and since has been renamed Canadian Tire Financial Services Limited.

In 1995, CTFS became the first non-deposit taking financial institution worldwide to launch a MasterCard
In 2003, Canadian Tire Bank was established, a Schedule

1 bank under the Canada Bank Act. Schedule 1 banks are domestic banks and are authorized under the Bank Act to accept deposits which may be eligible for deposit insurance provided by the Canadian Deposit Insurance Corporation (CDIC).
