S29-G SAME NUMBER REPLACEMENTS IN THE S28-G SERIES

It is of interest to note that the frequency of S29-G Snr's being found in the S28-G series is quite rare. I know of only one possible sheet of S29-G Snr's occuring in the S28-G series. If this is the case then you could say that they are 100 times more scarce than a normal replacement. Serial number 0009943000 is a S29-Gsnr7 Snr which bears the Thomas/Gauld signature and 0009943001 is a regular S28-G07 which bears the Pasternak/Gauld signature. This is the only example I have ever seen.

Finding regular S28G Snr's in the S28-G series is of course much easier and have seen quite a few more of these than the other. Serial number 0009980000 is an example of a S28-Gsnr7 and 0009980001 is the normal S28-G07.

One possible explanation for this particular group of Snr's is that the stock of S28-Ga replacements may have been used up as these serial numbers are quite high up in the range and may be nearing its end. I also suspect that only one batch of replacements was printed.

These are usually inserted if the top sheet, or any sheet for that matter, gets damaged. Rather than put in regular replacements, these are likely numbered separately and inserted in the stack of sheets prior to cutting, almost the same process as inserting regular replacements. This can also occur after the cutting for replacing individual coupons prior to wrapping.

These can be distinguished by the style of print in the serial number. See examples at right.
